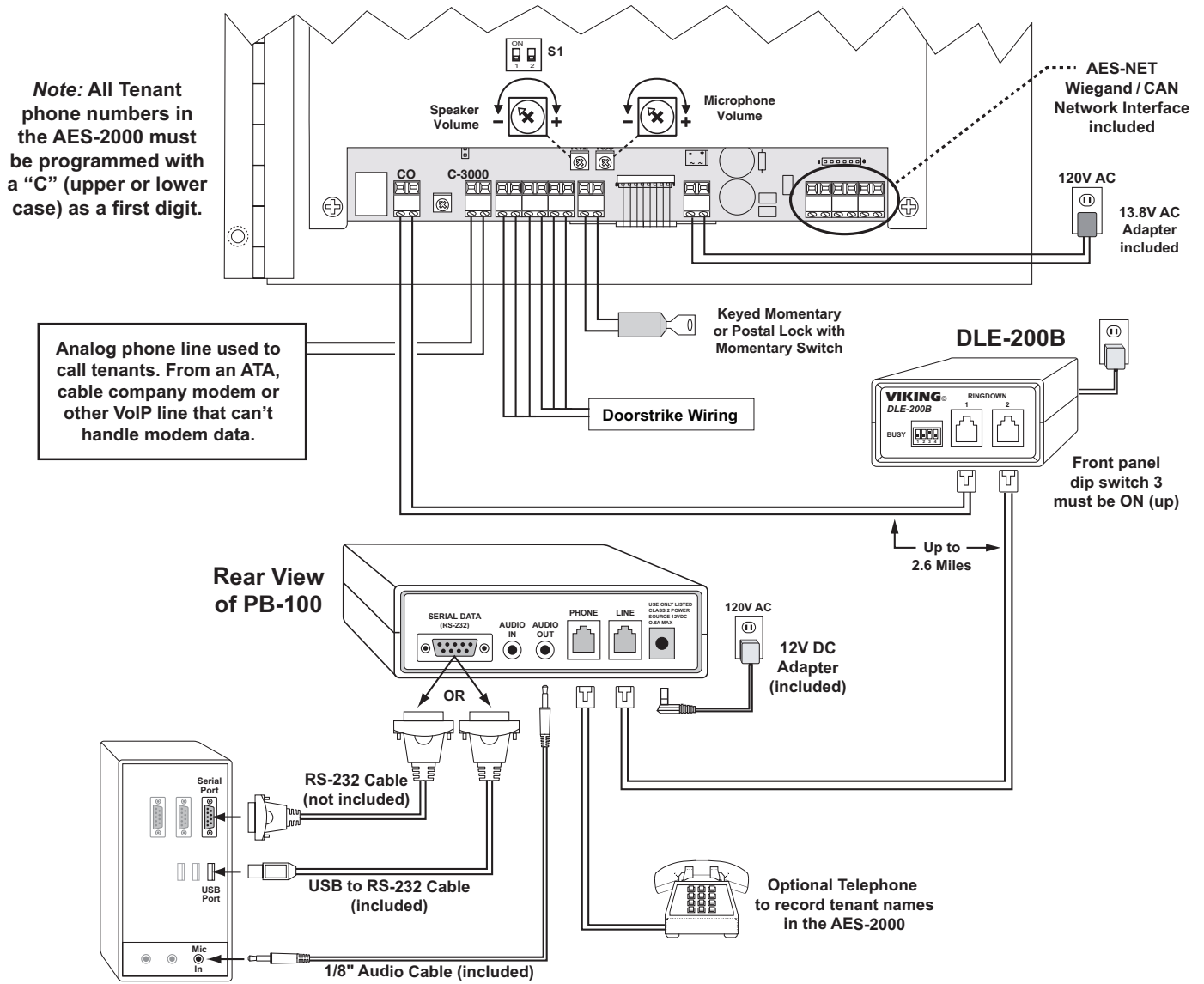


## Local AES-2000/AES-2005 Programming Using a Line Simulator

The **AES-2000/AES-2005** have an integrated modem for programming the tenant data and many of the modern analog lines don't handle the modem data well. Any packet loss, jitter or latency in the VoIP phone service will cause errors in the modem data. One alternative is to locally program the **AES-2000/AES-2005** through a line simulator when there is a single pair of wires available between the **AES-2000/AES-2005** and the PC used to program it.
